Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to your application of Increase of seats in MBBS course from 100 (+ 20 seats permitted under EWS Quota) to 150 at Nalanda Medical College, Nalanda u/s 10A of IMC Act, 1956 to now dissolved Board of Governors in Supersession of the Medical Council of India. It is brought to your notice that the Central Government has on 24th September 2020 notified fully the NMC Act, 2019. Section 61(2) of the NMC Act, 2019 provides as under:

"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, the educational standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder:"

2. Accordingly your application was processed u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 and Opening of the a New or Higher courses of Study or Training (including Post-graduate Course of Study or Training) and Increase of Admission Capacity in any Course of Study or Training (including a Post-graduate Course of Study or Training) Regulations, 2000. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board of the National Medical Commission has come to the conclusion that a letter may be issued for obtaining certain essential documents in connection with issuance of Letter of Permission (LoP) for increase of seats in MBBS course from 100 (+ 20 seats permitted under EWS Quota) to 150 at Nalanda Medical College, Patna u/s 28 and 61(2) of NMC Act, 2019 for the academic session 2020-21 subject to (i) submission of an undertaking from State Government, and (ii) submission of compliance report of setting up of BSL 2 lab.

3. Therefore it is requested to furnish the following documents/undertaking/acceptance of conditions to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board of the National Medical Commission:-

- The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in term of teaching and nonteaching staff, building. Equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.
- (ii) No students should be admitted in the above course till the formal permission of the Board of Governors in supersession of Medical Council of India is granted.

- (iii) Medical Colleges/ Institutions governed by the State Govt. are required to furnish an undertaking to provide funds in their budget till the facilities are fully provided as per time bound programme indicated by them.
- (iv) The Government Medical College [s] (except those located in J&K) should give an undertaking authorizing Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), Directorate General of Health Services, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. Government of India to include 15% of MBBS seats in All India Quota seats for the year 2020-21.

4. Formal permission for increase of seats in MBBS course from 100 (+ 20 seats permitted under EWS Quota) to 150 at Nalanda Medical College, Patna will be intimated on receipt of a compliance report fulfilling the conditions enumerated in paragraph 2 & 3 above. The acceptance letter along with bank guarantee/undertaking may be sent immediately to enable the Medical Assessment and Rating Board of the National Medical Commission to issue Letter of Permission for the year 2020-21 as early as possible from the date of issue of this letter.
