#### **Note -**

- ❖ Curriculum is under competency based act under the Post Graduation Medical Regulation ACT – 2021
- ❖ Post Graduate students will maintain dynamic e-log book which needs to be updated on weekly basis about the work carried out by them and training programmed undergone during the period.
- ❖ The Record Books (log) shall be checked and assessed periodically by the faculty members imparting the training.
- ❖ The Post Graduate student shall be required to participate in the teaching and training programme of undergraduate students and interns.
- ❖ All PG students pursuing MD/MS in broad specialities in all Medical Colleges/Institutions under the Indian Medical Council ACT 1956 shall undergo a compulsory residential rotation of 3 months in district hospital / district health system as a part of the course curriculum. Such rotation shall take place in the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> semester of the Post Graduate Programme. NMC has stated that the district residency programme scheme will be under the district residency programme Co-ordinator appointed by the health department.
